I will also have new membership forms for any of your friends.

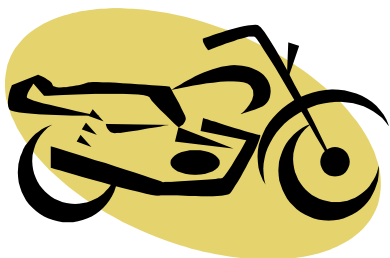
