Report Pre '65 2 Day Trial

This year the Pre 65 contrasted starkly with last years in the weather department, almost perfect, just to cold for the spectators, perfect for riding. Having a fairly late number gave me an opportunity to see most riders off and catch up with friends. Being and odd number, I turned left out of the ALCAN car park and headed for the first groups just off the road at Cnoc a Linnhe and Pollock Hill. It always takes a few sections to get into the groove and relax and by Loch Eilde Burn I felt vaguely in control. Most of Friday's 25 miles were tracks like the Mamore Road leading to rough moor, which was where I found a deep ditch quickly followed by a face plant. The helmet peak took most of the force; the rest was "dissipated" through my elbows and side. A few miles further on I came across a Spanish competitor who had snapped his primary chain, wonder if he is still up there?

Each day had a trip up Pipeline, which was quite grippy for a change. Very pleased to escape just dropping one at the top. As I was camping at Blackwater Hostel, I had first hand experience of the overnight rain, which fortunately stopped in the morning. Saturday's route again was 25 miles starting with a climb up to the Mamore Road, with groups of sections such as Stob Coire Eirghe and Sleubhaich. As the field is split for the second day this meant I was riding towards the front of the entry, cleaning the sections for later riders! The climb to Callert Pass took a bit of energy, as did the steep and slippery decent. Back onto the road heading back towards Kinlochleven and another go at Pipeline. Then back towards Glencoe for the last few groups. The sections consist of rocks and more rocks, something I have always enjoyed, as did the 2 riders I went round with. Surprisingly enough after some 50 miles and 60 sections we had all dropped almost exactly the same marks. The bike ran perfectly on both days, and again I managed to escape without a dreaded puncture.

I'm now looking forward to the Highland Two Day, mid June, Alvie, as well as Club trials through out the year. It would be great to see more Pre 65 bikes getting an airing! what are you waiting for?
