

At Section 6 markers had been mysteriously moved, and this happened on each lap, Markers should not be moved by anyone other than the Clerk of the Course, if you dislodge a marker, replace it in the exact spot, or ask an official for assistance.

If you see riders moving markers please report it to a Club Official.

Riders should be in their groups of 3 or 4 so someone must of observed the 'moving of markers' The markers in question were moved a good 2ft to the side, altering the route on the section a fair bit. This is unacceptable. To happen once is bad enough but to happen 3 times is a total disregard for all the work the Club Officials put in over the week-end.

Remember these guys laying out the trial, have been there all day Saturday, (some even stay over night, or sleep in their vans) are the last to leave on the Sunday, all so riders can have 4 hours on their bike.

We might need to consider actually determining the groups that riders go round in, in other words not with your pals. Again this all makes for more work for the Club Officials.

## **Bob MacGregor Trials Academy**

### Designed for new and experienced trials riders of all ages

This new venture is to give new and experienced youth and adult trials riders, from communities throughout Scotland, access to a chance of excellence and practice facility, a first class technical centre, giving them full opportunities for the proper introduction and development in these trial sports and for the benefit of current trials riders in Scotland.

It is a safe and legal place to practice and with the right calibre of sections to practice on for any level of rider, to allow each rider to develop his or her own riding skills, regardless of their age.

There are 10 different types of membership available to suit each member's budget and situation. Every penny of income will be reinvested back into the Academy by the Trust. We have a 5 year development plan – we are currently in talks with the local Councils and the Lottery. They have promised to back us 100%. We will be organising regular coaching sessions whatever your riding level, from beginner right up to expert, with local coaches and top UK riders coming up when available.

There will even be trials bike maintenance courses, this is all backed by the SACU.

### **Important**

Club Trials - Self Observing - Championship Points

It has been reported at a recent Closed to Club Trial that two club members (1 adult, 1 Youth) were seen punching out their cards incorrectly, in relation to marks actually dropped. This was witnessed on section 5 & 6 by three Committee members.

This is not acceptable behaviour and if any future incidents are reported it will result in championship points being removed from the riders in question.

Two Committee members did try to speak to those involved at the end of the trial, but unfortunately the riders in question were off playing for well over an hour.

All punch cards are checked at each event, checked again when results are being processed, and all paper work and cards are kept for 6 months. Committee members are watching at all events. Also when the results are being typed up, I know most of the riders and their ability, so if scores differ from one trial to the next, it is easily noticed. Most riders are fairly consistent with their results.

The Committee feel that if we do nothing about this, then it is never going to stop, these riders are cheating everybody, and in particular make it very unfair for the Youths, who are trying their best and marking their cards truthfully.

From now on at all Closed to Club trials the Clerk of the Course will reiterate in his briefing before the trial about the self marking of punch cards. Riders should not mark their own card.

Also we are going to put 1 punch at each section on a chain, so riders are not carrying their own.

### Sad News

Dave Fry, father of James Fry, (winner of the Bob MacGregor Trial 2009) died of a heart attack in July. Only weeks before his death he had a procedure to unblock an artery, so his death was even more of a shock. Dave had two great loves in his life, Trials and Rugby and was fortunate with two sons, James and Andy he could pursue both.

A former member of the Club also died this week, Davie Doig passed away peacefully on 13<sup>th</sup> August. Davie along with his son and Jim Miller were regular riding members for many years. He had been ill for some time now, but still managed to ride his road bike occasionally.
