Awards

- The T. Arnott Moffat Trophy to Adult Team making the best performance of the trial. The trophy will be held for one year or until the next team trial whichever is sooner.
- SACU Gilt Medal to the team making the best performance
- SACU Silver Medal to the team making the second best performance
- SACU Bronze Medal to the team making the third best performance
- Best over 40 Team
- Best Youth Team

Supplementary Regulations (Please Read Carefully)

1. Eligibility:- Entries will only be accepted from SACU affiliated Clubs. Each rider must be a register member of the entering club.
  - 1.1. The "Parent club" (from which the competition licence is obtained), will have first call on riders. A rider not required by the parent club may rider for another club of which he is a bone-fide member.
  - 1.2. Team Composition:- Adult
    - 1.2.1. Each Team shall consist of 4 riders of expert, non-expert or novice combination. No team shall consist of 4 experts, where a team has 3 experts the highest scoring expert shall not count towards the final team score
    - 1.2.2. Over 40, as above
    - 1.2.3. Youth, each team shall consist of any 4 riders of A or B Licence Combination.
2. Assessment of performance:- Only the best 3 performances shall count towards the final score, All 4 riders must complete the trial, Sign on at the start and sign off at the finish to qualify.
3. Observers:- Each Team must provide an observer, failure to do so will result in the team not being allowed to start. (Observers will be required to sign on with riders. This is a requirement from the SACU competition. Team Managers please play fair, expect your observer to be on a section for the day,)
4. The Entry fee £40.00 per team. Entries will only be accepted using the attached Team Entry Form, sent to the event Secretary. Dougie McNaughton, 134 Crieff Road, Perth, PH1 2NY 01738620260.
5. Entries will close on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2010.
6. Team Managers, who may be one of the riders, shall be nominated. All correspondence, including results, will be addresses to the manager.
7. A limit may be placed on the entry at the discretion on the promoting club.
8. No Fuel available at the start.
9. Directions to start from A822 Glimerton to Aberfeldy Road (nearest postcode PH7 3LN Foulford Inn)

In the interest of animal protection there will be no machines run or any practicing before riders are instructed to start the trial. Riders must follow the marked route at no time divert from it. Only official bikes will be permitted on any part of the land and any person caught not following these instructions will be asked to leave the venue. A report may be forwarded to the SACU. We as a club and you as the rider have a duty to respect the landowner and protect animals, so there will be no exceptions. Your co-operation will be greatly appreciated. We do enjoy this venue and have done for many years; we do not want to lose it.
